Religious & Legal Considerations

To get married in Gallatin County, here's what **Religious and Legal Considerations** you need to know:

- Marriage License: Both parties must apply for a marriage license at the Gallatin County Clerk's office. You'll both need a valid ID. The license costs around \$60, and there's no waiting period, so you can marry immediately after obtaining it. Office hours are Monday-Friday 8-4pm.
- Officiant: The marriage ceremony must be performed by a licensed officiant, such as a religious leader or a judge.
